Tools Required:

- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- 1/2" Wrench
- Small Hammer (optional)



1.) Punch out washer from the mailbox plate. Only one is required for assembly. Use a small hammer to gently knock it out or push with your thumb.



3.) Place washer over the center hole in the post cap and screw in the Cap Bolt using the provided Hex Key (Allen Wrench).

2.) Overlap the two plates and dry fit it to the bottom of the mailbox. Once you have the proper width, connect the plates using the post cap so the prongs fit through the slots on the plates.

4.) Using the Mailbox Bolts and Lock Nuts, attach the plates to the bottom of the mailbox

6.) Insert black post into top of spring and secure with provided bolt, washers, and lock nut.

The spring, 1' adapter, and natural ground adapter should be installed near road already.

Confirm all hardware is tightened securely.



5.) Place mailbox on the post, fitting the Cap over the post. Use provided self tapping screws to attach both components.

7.) Begin using your new Flex Mailbox!

- Mailbox should be installed between 6-8" from the front face of the curb to the mailbox door.
